The Aiguille du Pécelet is the highest peak with its 3561 meters, it rises over the Dents du Burgin, the Sommet of the Saulire and the Pointe du Fruit. All this awesome heights and the sharp crests that link them together surround one of the most famous resort of the Alps, Méribel. A century old resort that has been one of the first to associate winter sports and luxury holidays in prestigious residences. An image of excellence that it has built over the years and had never ceased to represent.

Always careful about the extension of its architectural heritage, every new mansion had to be build accordingly to the Savoyard style that privileges wood and local stone; a rule the chalet respects thoroughly. The proud construction is preceded on the south side by a private garden and a terrace, adjacent to an outdoor pool and Jacuzzi.

The authentic aspect is of course no opponent to modernity, and especially technology. The cinema is equipped with Dolby sound, the game room with a game console, a billiard and a table soccer. The aesthetic modernity is also present in the two stories high living room and in the large dining room. The furniture is sophisticated, the artworks mostly contemporary, and the wood beams, wood floors and the superb fire place are telling that this is, effectively, Haute-Savoie. A reminder that is confirmed by the marvelous landscapes that lie behind the floor to ceiling windows.

This juxtaposition of subtle contrasts is also to be found in the suites which all have an adjacent bathroom and a plasma screen. The master's bedroom occupies the whole floor and benefits from a fire place and a double bathtub.

The decoration takes care to dress all the details with the specificities of one of the most beautiful region of France. Considering the ensemble, opulent and masterful, it is absolutely in harmony with the spirit that has always marked Méribel as being different.
